Broad Spit Park: boat access only	43.8	S	-	A pristine wilderness park on Tarboo Bay, visit by boat only, take only pictures, leave only footprints.
Chimacum Park: 9635 SR 19, Chimacum	14	-	4	Easy access picnic shelter and restrooms, frequently used as a rest stop and meeting area.
Courthouse Park: 1820 Jefferson St, Port Townsend	2	-	3	Maple trees, green grass, tennis and basketball, provides open space in front of historic courthouse.
East Beach Park: 330 East Beach Rd., Nordland	1	S	2	Historic picnic shelter, restrooms, new fireplace warms you after beach walk. Views of Admiralty Inlet
Gibbs Lake Park: 110 Gibbs Lake Rd., Chimacum	310	F	1	Mature trees, miles of trails, 40 acre lake, cliffs, restrooms, amazing mountain biking challenges.
H.J. Carroll Park: 9884 SR 19, Chimacum	50	F	6	Athletic fields, large pavilion for weddings & reunions, creek access, exercise trails, BMX track, disc golf, smaller pavilion for parties or meetings, native plant gardens, restrooms, playground, picnics!
Hicks Park: 1090 Shine Rd., Port Ludlow	1	S	1	Best boat ramp on hood canal! Restroom, parking, picnics, calm water, swimming, have fun!
Indian Island: 3456 Fort Flagler Rd., Port Hadlock	220	S	8	Two miles of beach walking & upland trails, clamming, picnic shelter, restrooms, birdwatching, swimming, exploration, fishing, located at the head of beautiful Oak Bay
Irondale Beach Park: 562 Moore St., Port Hadlock	12.5	S	1	Historic site of Irondale Mill, beautiful sandy beach, mouth of Chimacum Creek, views of P.T. Bay
Irondale Park: 61 Alma St., Port Hadlock	3.00	-	2	Athletic fields, playground, basketball courts, restrooms, water, picnics. A wonderful family place.

Port Townsend Community Center: 620 Tyler St.	1	-	3	Birthday rentals, summer camps, afterschool programs, and the offices of our incredible recreation program staff. Seniors Center is upstairs, and kids rec center is downstairs! Stop and book a party.
Quilcene Community Park: 294964 Hwy. 101, Quilcene	8	-	2	Nice playground, basketball & tennis court, picnic shelter, skatepark, restroom, historic Best crawler.
Quilcene River Park: 41 Muncie Ave. Quilcene	1	F	3	Small neighborhood park on the Big Quilcene River. Check out the river, picnic or fish at this spot.
Quilcene Sports Park: Deema Smakman Rd., Quilcene	14	-	-	Owned by Jefferson County, used exclusively for South Jefferson Little League: (360) 765-4788.
Upper Oak Bay: 290 Cleveland St., Port Ludlow	5	S	2	First come, first served campground with some hook ups, playground, restroom, super views.
Cape George Trailhead Park: 733 Cape George Road	43	-	1	Parking for the Larry Scott Trail, restroom, single track trails, views, horse trails, easy access.

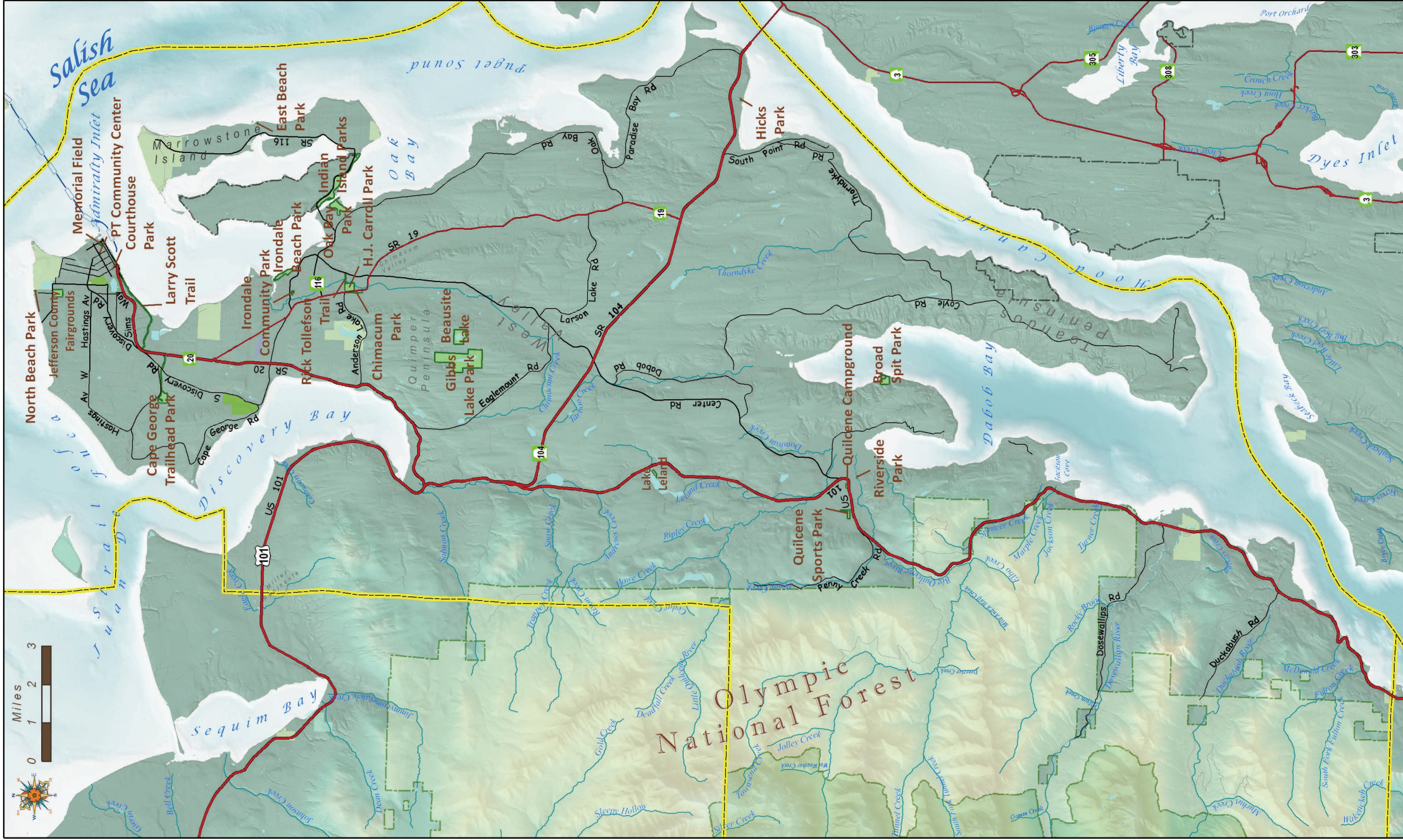
